<p>1. UV nail tunnel</p> <p>You can use LEDs, but tubes are faster, we prefer the 4 x 15W tube configuration for even light distribution.</p>	\$19	
<p>2. Acrylic or glass clamp</p> <p>You can use two sheets of glass with bevelled edges. Just stick some 2.6mm bearers around the edge and use two bulldog clips. Alternatively buy an acrylic clamp with bearers around the edge and magnets inserted in the bearers to lock the two halves together.</p>	\$2.50	
<p>3. Stampmaker sachets</p> <p>Boxes of 5 x A7 and 10 x A8 size available from Photocentric.</p>	\$0.40 per A8	
<p>4. Inkjet film</p> <p>Ink receptive clear Reprojet inkjet film from Folex or similar.</p>	\$0.50 per A4

<p>5. Brush</p> <p>A soft shoe brush to clean the stamp.</p>	\$0.30	
<p>6. Tray</p> <p>Plastic food tray that fits inside the Stampmaker light unit.</p>	\$0.08	
<p>7. Timer</p> <p>Kitchen stopwatch timer.</p>	\$1.00	

User provides

1. Scissors or Knife

2. Ink jet printer

Any inkjet printer will print dark enough, you need to reverse the clear and black parts to make a negative and then print on a Photo Paper Matte setting or similar.



3. Water and soap

To wash the liquid polymer in and clear water to fill in the tray to post expose it in.
